Head Coach/Assistant General Manager

A Walla Walla native and product of DeSales High School, J.C. played baseball at Walla Walla Community College before finishing his playing career at Shreveport College in Louisiana. An infielder and pitcher, the highlight of his career was a complete game win against national powerhouse LSU before a sold out crowd.



While a nation-wide search took place for the person to lead the team in the dugout, it was the mix of hometown understanding and baseball smarts that made J.C. a logical choice for the Sweets. J.C. is an assistant coach at Walla Walla Community College.

Mark Michaud #57

Pitching Coach

Mark Michaud leads the Sweets' pitching staff. In 2011 he directed a Sweets staff that finished with the second-best ERA in the league at 2.62. Michaud began his coaching career at Division III powerhouse Eastern Connecticut, and helped the Warriors win National Championships in 1998 and 2002. After leaving ECSU '02, Michaud spent the next six years serving coaching, re-cruiting and camp duties at Wisconsin-Platteville, Rockford College, Siena College and the University of Maine before returning to the Warriors in 2009.

Rob shares his life with his wife Kristine and their five children Mary Ann, Bobby, Sandra Jean, Billy and Teresa Kay. From Yakima, he spent a year as Asst. Coach at Cle Elum HS before spending three at East Valley High. He moved to Walla Walla in '91 to coach one year at WWCC, followed by 18 at De Sales HS, where he was part of 16 state championship teams. Now in his third year at WWCC, he's in his third year managing his son's Cox-Jones Little League team.



TONIGHT'S GAME

The Sweets took home their first win of the 2013 season last night and look to continue the trend tonight. Starting pitcher Taylor Jones will take the mound to oppose the Bend Elks in the rubber game. A freshman out of Gonzaga University, Jones compiled a 5.29 ERA in 17 innings in the spring of 2013. At 6' 7", Jones is an imposing presence on the mound. A Kent, WA, native, he's racked up 19 strikeouts in his time in Division I.

REWIND RECAP

The Sweets bounced back from a disappointing Opening Day loss to win 4-2 over the Bend Elks at Borleske Stadium Thursday. Starter Chris Lovejoy went 7 innings and struck out 8 in a no decision. Kramer Lindell hit the first Walla Walla home run of the season as the Sweets rallied in the 7th and 8th innings to take the lead and not look back. Jake Campeau won in relief and Sean-Luke Brija notched his first save of the year.

ABOUT THE ELKS...

Bend finished the 2012 season with the same record as the Sweets (24-30), ending up in fourth place in the five-team WCL West Division. The Elks swept the first four games against Walla Walla last year before the Sweets salvaged the final two games, and managed to outscore Bend 24-23 for the season.
