TONIGHT'S GAME

Tonight the Walla Walla Sweets are coming off a 13-3 romp over the San Francisco Seals, who committed seven errors in the field on Saturday. Sweets righthander Connor Dillman, a Sophomore out of Emory College takes the mound tonight for the home team. He posted 2.20 ERA for the Eagles, and in 82 innings of work, he struck out 68 while only walking 43. Dillman's 2012 freshman season was one of the best by a rookie in Eagles history.

REWIND RECAP

Shaky defense spelled doom for the visiting San Francisco Seals Saturday night as the defense committed seven errors, and the Sweets took advantage. Short stop Scott Silva was the offensive highlight of the night as he went 3-for-5 with 3 runs scored and 5 RBI. Center fielder Beau Bozett was stellar as well, going 2-for-3 with 2 runs scored, 2 walks and 2 runs batted in to support starting pitcher Drew Christina who threw 5.2 innings of no-hit baseball en route to the win. Walla Walla scored 13 runs on 11 hits.
