**PREVIOUS RESULTS**

**LAST NIGHT:**

The Sweets rode strong pitching and just enough hitting to a 1-0 non-league victory over the Central Oregon Bucks. Alex Fisher got the start for Walla Walla, striking out eight while allowing just one hit through six innings. Renae Martinez' RBI double in the second inning was the only run the Sweets would need, as Jake Campeau pitched scoreless 7th and 8th innings, and Matt Majors retired the side in order in the 9th to continue his impressive relief showing this season. For the Bucks, starter Clay Bauer lasted four innings and took the tough loss while only allowing four hits, and Rio Gomez held the Sweets hitless through their final four innings, striking out six while walking only one.

**THE BIG PICTURE:**

Upon completing their sweep of Wenatchee two days ago, the Sweets moved into a tie for second place in the East division with the Applesox, now four and a half games behind first-place Yakima Valley. The Sweets will now face the Applesox in a three-game series at Borleske, hoping to move into sole possession of second place with a series win.
