**LAST NIGHT:**

Andrew Mendenhall hit a solo home run in each of his first two at-bats, and Aldo Ferrante hit his second homer of the season in the bottom of the 8th to break a 2-2 tie that had stood since the 3rd inning. Spencer Hobson pitched well through 6 2/3 innings, allowing just two runs on six hits, one a solo home run by Cowlitz' Joey Greco. The Black Bears tied the game at 3-3 in the top of the 9th, but Walla Walla's Kyle Nixon came through with a two-out RBI infield single in the bottom of the inning for the walk-off win, 4-3.

**THE BIG PICTURE:**

Tonight is the last meeting of the season between the Sweets and the Black Bears. The Sweets clinched the series victory with last night's win, and will look to sweep the series tonight to continue gaining ground on first place Yakima Valley in the East division standings.
