Offensively, seven players in the Sweets' starting lineup collected at least one hit, also taking advantage of five walks and three Kelowna errors. The Falcons managed a single run during a brief first-inning rally, but a Nick Minter solo home run in the 4th inning was the only other offense the visitors' bats could muster against Sweets pitching.

With the series tied at a game apiece, the Sweets look to gain ground on their division rivals with a series win. The Sweets will travel to Corvallis next for a three-game series with the Knights, who sit in third place in the South division, two games out of first place.
